Questions:

Is it possible that God could take on human flesh and become a man, like one of us? What does Philippians 2:8 say about this? Matt. 19:26?

Do you believe that Jesus was really a man, or that He just appeared like a man? What difference does our belief make here?

What did his contemporaries have to say about Him? Note these passages from the Gospel of St. John:

- 1:30 After me comes a man who ranks before me . . .
- 4:29 Come see a man who told me all that I ever did . . .
- 5:11 The man who healed me said to me, take up your pallet and walk . . .
- 7:4 No man works in secret if he seeks to be known openly . .
- 7:15 How is it that this man has learning, when he has never studied?
- 7:31 When the Christ appears, will He do more signs than this man has done?
- 7:35 Where does this man intend to go that we shall not find him?
- 7:45 No man ever spoke like this man!
- 8:40 And Jesus said of himself, “Now you seek to kill me, a man who told you the truth . . .”

Was He in every way a human, just as we are, subject to all the trials of life like we are? Note Hebrews 2: 16 – 18 and its application here.
