

# Summer Day Camp at Lamb of God

**Week 1 June 18-21**  **Kids Create Super Snacks** **\$115**  
(No Food Allergies Please)

Campers will prepare and eat snacks each day based upon children's favorite picture books. Campers will use easy-to-read rebus recipes to make applesauce pies, graham cracker houses, berry parfaits and more. Campers will also decorate an apron to take home along with a cookbook of the recipes they prepare.

**Week 2 June 25-28**  **From My Head Down To My Toes** **\$115**

How does it all work? Campers will participate in hands-on science activities to explore the human body and the five senses. From life size self portraits to hearing their own heart beat, campers will have many opportunities for active learning. Crafts will include skeleton art and simple science experiments.

**Week 3 July 9-12**  **Fiesta** **\$115**

Los ninos will explore Mexican culture while enjoying some of the traditions and games that children play in Mexico. Campers will taste some local favorites at snack time and will make a pinch pot, decorate maracas and learn some simple Spanish words.

**Week 4 July 16-19**  **Under The Big Top** **\$115**

The circus is coming to summer camp! Get into the act as we pretend to be circus performers, circus animals and clowns. Campers will create circus animal art and shape clowns. What is a circus without popcorn? Campers will enjoy this fun snack while engaging in songs and games.

**Week 5 July 23-26**  **Puppet Power** **\$115**

Campers will create a variety of puppets- from stick puppets and finger puppets to paper and felt hand puppets. Using some favorite picture books as a starting point, puppeteers will have opportunities to create character voices and use their puppets to act out stories and finger plays.

**Week 6 July 30-August 2**  **Young Artists** **\$115**

Campers will learn about and create art pieces in the style of some of the Great Masters. Artists will study the work of Henri Matisse and create a masterpiece of their own using his paper cutting technique. Our young artists will have opportunities to create a sculpture and learn color mixing in the style of Seurat (pointillism). I SPY art games will introduce campers to the works of many artists.
